Dear Pastor & Praying Friends,

"And He (Jesus) entered into one of the ships...(and) he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a drought...and when they had this done, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake." Luke 5: 3a, 4-6. This episode in the life of the disciples was one of great spiritual awakening in which they began to realize just how powerful the Lord is and how unworthy they were for receiving such a blessing. Every time we see new souls come into the "nets" we too sit in admiration and wonder.

ADDED SOULS

This past summer I began giving classes on how we can become "fishers of men", and it's paying off! Our brethren are finding the courage to share their faith with more boldness and enthusiasm than ever. Even during the classes a new lady from Peru who started participating realized she needed to be saved! She later said that in the churches back in Peru she never heard such clear explanations of what one needs to do to get saved. The following week she came with a willing heart and trusted Christ to become her Savior. Shortly after a young lady from our church called Tatiana invited a friend of hers called Henrique to church, motivated by what she was leaning in her soul-winning classes. Seeing how motivated Henrique was to get saved a few days later she shared what she had learned and led him to Christ. While this was happening I received a note from a friend that said: "In a recent survey 93% of believers in the United States have never led anyone to Christ in their life". This large number surprised me, but it made me realize just how vital it is to train our people in performing this great task.

INTENSIVE BIBLE CLASSES

In the past it was normally us who invited pastors and missionaries to come our church to give special intensive Bible classes. But during the month of November it was I who was invited to do this. Brother Kent Albright, who serves in the province of Salamanca (seven hours north of

us) asked me to come and teach a 9 hour course on the book of Nehemiah, as part of their training program for workers & leaders. Eighteen students benefited from the teaching,





but I believe it was I who was mostly blessed, for the months I invested to prepare and organize these lessons. To be able to teach them in this kind of setting greatly inspired me.

MISSION'S CONFERENCE

During the last week of November we celebrated our 22nd mission's conference with renewed faith that God again would work a miracle on our congregation. Last year our church committed to give close to 10,000.00 Euros to mission in spite of the unstable job conditions that our people were experiencing. By God's grace we closed our missions year not only reaching our goal, but going beyond

it surpassing it by 2,200.00 Euros. Praise God! We don't know what the Lord has prepared for us for this coming year, but knowing how incredibly gracious He is we want to take a step of faith and go beyond our strength and take on one more missionary with support.



CHRISTMAS SEASON OUTREACH

As usual, with Christmas comes a busy season of preparations. This year, among other things, we have prepared a special bilingual Christmas service in order to invite as many people as possible to hear about God´s ultimate gift to mankind.
